What is an Apprenticeship?

Apprenticeships provide people with the start they need to progress within their chosen career, This enables the learner to earn a salary and job specific skills while they learn. Apprenticeships are nationally recognised qualifications and are designed to provide the learner with practical skills and knowledge. Once completed the Apprenticeship Framework provides the learner with a suite of qualifications that are job specific to their chosen career.

Different levels of Apprenticeship

There are two levels of Apprenticeship, depending on the learning experience, previous qualifications and abilities they can choose an Apprenticeship or Advanced Apprenticeship, also known as Level 2 and Level 3.

Intermediate Apprenticeship

Funding available for 16-18, 19-24, 24+ year olds

An alternative to GCSEs/GNVQ Intermediate/BTEC

Equivalent to 5 GCSEs at Grace A-C

Study Diploma Level

Functional Skills Training

Technical Certificate*

Typically lasts 12-18 months

Advanced Apprenticeship

Funding available for 16-24, 14-24, 24+ year olds

An alternative to A Levels/HNC/BTEC

Equivalent to 2 A Levels



Typically lasts 12-24 months
