Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, (of) the EU

Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, and Sweden.

The European The EEA includes EU countries and also Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway. It allows them **Economic Area** to be part of the EU's single market. Switzerland is neither an EU nor EEA member but is

part of the single market - this means Swiss nationals have the same rights to live and work in the UK as other EEA

nationals.

**British Overseas** Learner from these territories are eligible subject to the usual 3 year residency rule:

Anguilla, Bermuda, British Antarctic Territory, British Indian Ocean Territory, British Virgin Islands, Cayman Islands, **Territories** Falkland Islands, Gibraltar, Montserrat, Pitcairn Islands, Saint Helena, Ascension and Tristan da Cunha, South Georgia

and the South Sandwich Islands, Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia, Turks and Caicos Islands

# **EU Settlement Scheme**

- Indefinite Leave to Enter or Remain only those who are noted as a victim of domestic abuse or a bereaved partner bypass the standard 3 year residency ruling.
- Ukrainian schemes
- Afghan schemes
- Refugee status
